CITY COUNCIL REGULAR MEETING

1. CALL TO ORDER

The City Council Members of the City of Johnson City, Texas held a Regular Meeting on Tuesday, February 7, 2017 in the City Council Chambers located at City Hall, 303 E Pecan Drive, Johnson City Texas.

City Council members present were: Mayor Dawn Capra, Mayor Pro-Tem Rhonda Stell, Mitchell Liesmann, and Shelton K. Coleman. Council Member Dildine was absent. A quorum was present.

Mayor Dawn Capra called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

4. PUBLIC COMMENTS AND ANNOUNCEMENTS:

Resident Don Barrett spoke about repealing the Johnson Amendment and would like the City Council to discuss it further at the next Council Meeting.
